

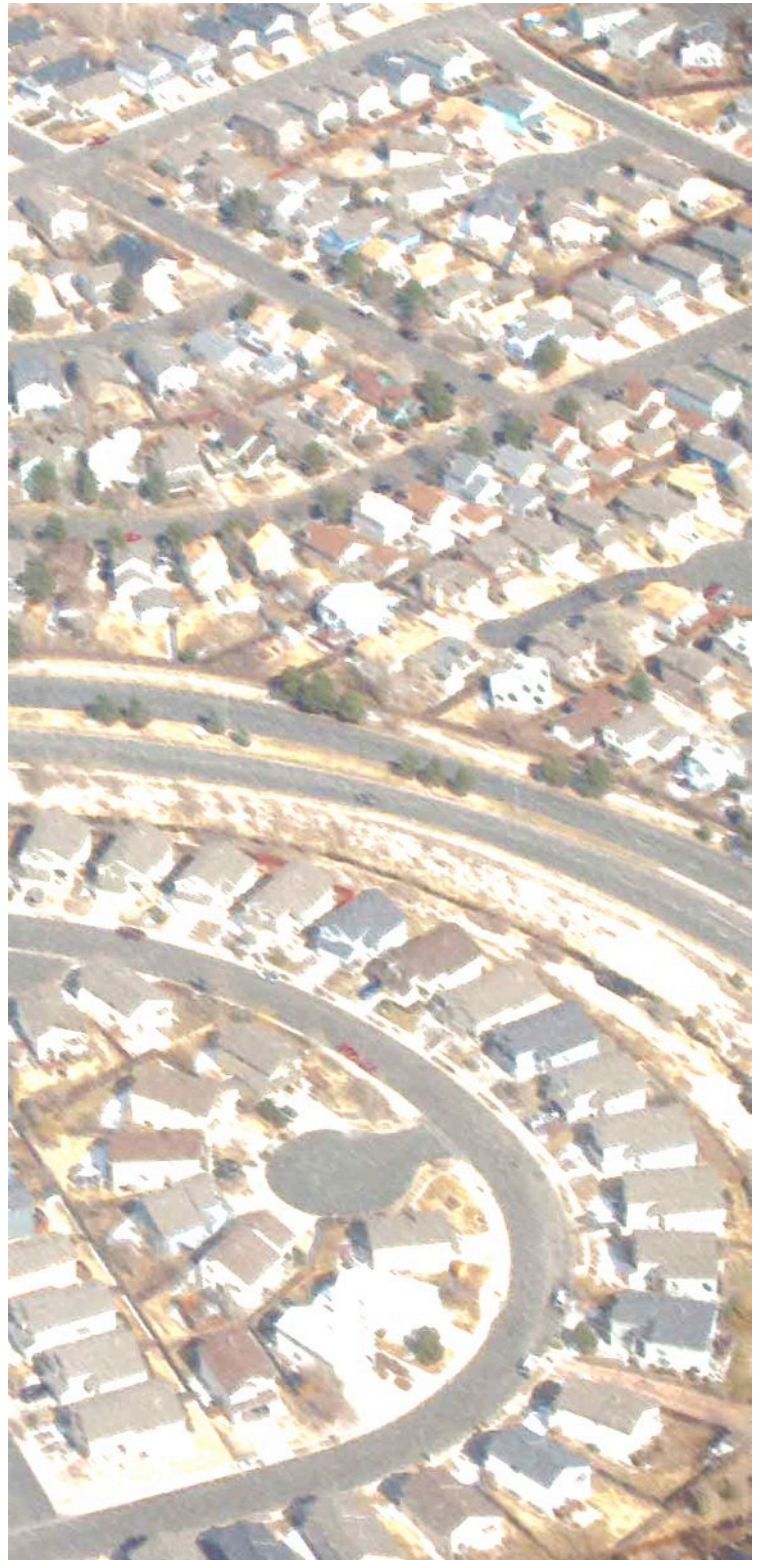
Little boxes on the hillside,
